Project Delivery Method:	Construction Manager At Risk (CMR)* - Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP): A Construction Manager at Risk shall be selected to publically bid the project elements and enter into a GMP contract with the State. After consultation with and approval by the commissioner, the CMR shall award subcontracts to responsible qualified subcontractors submitting the lowest bids to build the Project.		
	*Construction Manager at Risk (CMR) reviews and participates in design and the production of the construction documents with Owner and Architect. The CMR solicits trade bids on behalf of the Owner from trade subcontractors on a competitive basis. The CMR shall agree upon a Guaranteed Maximum Price to perform the work identified in the Bid Documents and enters into contracts with these trade subcontractors to perform their trade work.		
	Important Note: Projects that a firm has completed as "General Contractor" or a "Construction Manager as Agent" (i.e. Projects where the firm did not enter into contracts with these trade subcontractors to perform their trade work) shall not qualify as acceptable CMR Project Experience for this Selection.

	This project consists of the comprehensive renovation and expansion of Willard Hall (approx. 60,125 gross square feet of space on four levels, including basement) and DiLoreto Hall (approx. 45,476 gross square feet of space on four levels, including basement) at Central Connecticut State University, New Britain. Expansion will take place through the construction of a 35,300 gross square foot "in-fill" structure connecting the two buildings. The "in-fill" will provide additional space to meet programmatic needs of the university.	
	Some of the departments and activities to be considered for relocation to the renovated and expanded facilities include: Admissions, Financial Aid, Registrar, English Department, Modern Languages, Enrollment Center/Continuing Education Offices, Prevention and Counseling Services, Career Services and Cooperative Education, Pre-Collegiate Access Services/The Learning Center, the Advising Center, Veterans' Center, Student Conduct, Health Services, and other University departments. Relocation activities associated with this project will be phased prior to construction in order to minimize disruption to activities and departments housed in Willard and DiLoreto Halls. The CMR will work with the architect and the relocation specialists to assist the university in implementation strategies.	
	The project includes substantial building and life safety code upgrades and complete renovation/replacement of the building systems, including but not limited to the HVAC systems, connections to the Energy Center steam and chilled water systems, INVENSYS Energy Management Systems, total electrical upgrade, new elevators, telecommunications, new addressable fire alarm and sprinkler system and emergency lighting. The renovations will include exterior masonry modifications/repairs, substantial building envelope improvements, new windows, new sloped roofs and new reconfiguration of interiors to provide additional classrooms and offices, new interior and exterior security access hardware, security camera systems and audio-visual for Smart Classrooms.	
	The project will include abatement and remediation of regulated and hazardous materials including Asbestos Containing Materials (ACM), Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCB's) and Lead Based Paints (LBP).
