Failure to do so may subject Bid Proposers to disqualification.

The following clarifications are applicable to drawings and specifications for the project referenced above.

Item 1

In Section 012000 CONTRACT CONSIDERATIONS, Subsection 012216 UNIT PRICE SCHEDULE Paragraph B **DELETE** Subparagraph 1.1.3 in its entirety and **REPLACE** with new Subparagraph 1.1.3 to read "Remove damaged or deteriorated existing cementitious fill and replace with lightweight concrete. Carry an allowance of 1000 sq. ft. as part of the base bid. Unit Price to Add \$10.00/ sq. ft.; Deduct \$8.00/ sq. ft."

Item 2

In Section 012000 CONTRACT CONSIDERATIONS, Subsection 012216 UNIT PRICE SCHEDULE Paragraph B **ADD** new Subparagraph 1.1.4 to read "Repair existing damaged or deteriorated masonry. Carry an allowance of 100 sq. ft. as part of the base bid. Unit Price to Add \$20.00/ sq. ft.; Deduct \$16.00/ sq. ft."

Item 3


Section 042000 UNIT MASONRY ASSEMBLIES, Article 1.2 - SUMMARY: At Subparagraph 1 **DELETE** text that reads "Repointing and parging of existing masonry" and **REPLACE** with text to read "Repair of existing masonry to include removal and replacement of loose, spalled and broken bricks."

Item 4

Section 042000 UNIT MASONRY ASSEMBLIES: **REMOVE** Articles 3.4 REPOINTING MASONRY and Article 3.5 PARGING entirely without substitution.
