The following clarifications are applicable to drawings and specifications for the project referenced above.

Item 1:

Question: The spec section 01 35 26 GOVERNMENT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS requires to provide a Site Safety and Health Officer (SSHO) (Level 4) at the work site at all times to perform safety and occupational health management, surveillance, inspections, and safety enforcement for the Contractor. Also, a Certified Safety Professional (CSP) at the work site to perform safety and occupational health management, surveillance, inspections, and safety enforcement for the Contractor. Please confirm that these two are required to be on site everyday throughout the work duration of the project. Should this be an allowance or unit price?

Answer:

The SSHO is required to be on site every day per the specifications. The CHP shall be on-site at least weekly or whenever work or testing is being performed. The costs for both should be included in your Base Bid.

Delete Specification section 01 35 26 sub-section 1.6/F.2-c: c. Be on-site whenever work or testing is being performed.

Insert Specification section 01 35 26 sub-section 1.6/F.2-c: c. Be on-site at least weekly or whenever work or testing is being performed.
