## **Bonding and Insurance Coverage Requirements:**

Sufficient Bonding and Insurance Coverage <u>are not required</u> for the SBE/MBE firms to be <u>Pre-Selected to bid</u> on Minor Capital Projects under \$500,000.

However, sufficient Bonding (i.e., a performance bond and a labor and materials bond for a construction contract price range up to \$500,000) and required Insurance Coverage (see Division 8 of the QBS Submittal Booklet) <u>are required</u> for the SBE/MBE firms to be <u>awarded a contract</u> for a Minor Capital Project under \$500,000.
