Bonding and Insurance Coverage Requirements:

Sufficient Bonding and Insurance Coverage **are not required** for the SBE/MBE firms to be **Pre-Selected to bid** on Minor Capital Projects under \$500,000.

However, sufficient Bonding (i.e., a performance bond and a labor and materials bond for a construction contract price range up to \$500,000) and required Insurance Coverage (see Division 8 of the QBS Submittal Booklet) **are required** for the SBE/MBE firms to be **awarded a contract** for a Minor Capital Project under \$500,000.
