

## **Invitation to Prequalify & Bid**

## University of Connecticut Project #901667 Fine Arts Phase II Renovation and Improvements

You are hereby invited to bid the University of Connecticut - Fine Arts Phase II (Project #901667) in Storrs, CT.

Job Description: The Fine Arts Phase II project adds a 27,600 SF addition to the existing Drama/Music/Nafe Katter Theater to serve as a centralized shops and theater production facility, housing scene, paint, prop, lighting and costume shops and support functions. The addition will provide critical linkage between the separate Fine Arts buildings that currently does not exist, accessible access to the second floor of the Drama/Music building and a new entry lobby on the north side of the complex. The project also includes removal and replacement of the existing exterior glazing systems facades on the Storrs and Bolton Road. Lastly, the project includes site modifications, utility infrastructure relocations, modification of the adjacent staff parking lot and the addition of site amenities which coordinate with the University's master plan for development. The construction schedule is expected to be from May 2018 through September 2019.

Submit the bid package per instructions no later than the dates in the instructions below. Bids will only be accepted from contractors who have been prequalified specific to this project and each bid package

- 8. This project has a Project Labor Agreement (PLA).
- 9. WT, at the advice of UConn, reserves the right to waive minor irregularities in bids and prequalifications.
