Please Note: This Invitation to Bid is reserved for contractors currently holding a certificate, with <u>any one</u> of the following Prequalification Classifications: GENERAL BUILDING CONSTRUCTION (GROUP A), GENERAL BUILDING CONSTRUCTION (GROUP C), SITEWORK, or MASONRY issued through Connecticut's Department of Administrative Services' Prequalification Program. Bidders are advised that both the DAS Prequalification Certificate and Update (Bid) Statement must accompany the bid proposal; failure to do so will result in rejection of the bid.

The Project Description:

At four (4) Residential Halls at Southern Connecticut State University - Chase, Hickerson, Wilkinson and Neff:

- 1. The Contractor shall provide a lift, and necessary trained personnel and spotters for the Architect to visually inspect all facades, top to bottom.
- 2. There will be replacement of brick veneer if judged necessary by the architect based on the bidder's Unit Prices.
- 3. There will be replacement of lintels as identified in the Contract Documents.
- 4. The remainder of the existing brick veneer will be pinned back to existing concrete or CMU backup.

To ensure that all prospective bidders have a complete set of the Drawings and Project Manual, all firms who wish to bid on the project must buy the Drawings and Project Manual from SCSU.

Plans and specifications will be available at the mandatory pre-bid meeting. There will be a \$100.00 non-refundable fee for the set of plans & specifications. No cash or credit cards will be accepted. Checks are to be made payable to "Southern Connecticut State University".
