The Town of Coventry seeks to engage a Consulting Engineering firm to provide engineering services for the investigation, traffic data collection and analysis, survey, design, permitting, and contract plans and documents for the realignment of the Swamp Road intersection at Boston Turnpike (CT RT 44). This project will also look at the Northfield Road intersection with Boston Turnpike.

Construction Phase funding has been secured through the Connecticut Department of Transportation under the Local Capital Improvements Program (LOTCIP) administrated by the Capital Region Council of Governments (CRCOG). Firms responding to this invitation should be of adequate size and sufficiently staffed to perform the assignment described above.

The selected firm must meet all Town, State and Federal affirmative action and equal employment opportunity practices.

All Proposals must be **stamped** received by the Office of the Town Manager, no later than 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 9, 2019. Responses received after this date will not be considered.
