DPH RFP #2020 – 0903 Medical – Dental Innovation Project: Integrating Oral Health and Chronic Disease RFP Questions and Answers

1. How will it be determined which Component will be awarded, assuming fund availability?

All applicants are required to apply to Component 1, but have the option to apply to Component 2 as well. Five awardees will be selected for Component 1, and of the five, two will also be awarded Component 2.

2. The legal notice states that 5 awards will be made, yet the Contract Awards, if fully implemented, seem to suggest 7 awards. Is there overlap, i.e. will a recipient of Component 1 also be eligible for Component 2, either concomitantly or sequentially?

See above.

3. Are there features of the application which will weigh more heavily for one Component or the other, or is the aggregate score the predominant determinant of which Component is awarded?

The same scoring criteria will apply to all proposals, whether or not they include Component 1 only, or both components. The final score will be the determinant for funding.

4. The instructions state that the award is dependent on availability of funding. Is there any possibility that there will be less funding or even no funding available?

The awards are 100% federally funded and funding is not guaranteed.

5. Must we have a (HPSA) Dental Health Discipline in order to apply?

Proposals will be accepted from Connecticut federally qualified health centers and community health centers with dental HPSA designation.
