SPECIFICATIONS

- DELETE Section 00300 Form For General Bid in its entirety, and Replace with new Section 00300R Form For General Bid.
- 2. **REVISED** Section 2.01 MATERIALS in specification 02630, page no. 02630-2 as following.
 - A. Ductile iron pipe shall be a rubber ring compression type joint (push on), Thickness Class 54, shall be the size shown on the Contract Drawings, and conform to ANSI A21.11. All pipes shall be made of grade 60-42-10 ductile iron. All ductile iron pipe shall be centrifugally cast and conform to ANSI A21.51 and ANSI A21.50. All ductile iron pipe shall be lined with double-thickness, cement mortar in accordance with the latest edition of ANSI/AWWA, C104/A21.4 and ANSI/AWWA C151/A21.51 and seal coated. The standard exterior bituminous coating shall be provided. The pipe shall be in nominal laying lengths of 18 to 20 feet. All pipe joints shall be restrained and provided with a boltless, push-on joint capable of being deflected after assembly and conforming to ANSI/AWWA C111/A21.11 and with a pressure rating of 350 PSI. McWane Ductile Sure-Stop 350 gaskets, or equal. Designs using set screws or requiring field welding are not acceptable.
- 3. **DELETE** Section 2.02 C Manufacturers in specification 02630, page no. 02630-2.
