BID ADDENDUM #2

DESCRIPTION:

Pre-fabricated Steel Buildings and Cold Storage Roofing Structures

FOR:

Department of Transportation, All Using State Agencies, Political Subdivisions, and Not-for-Profit Organizations

BIDDERS NOTE:

Addendum 2 is issued to post the questions submitted with answers.

Q1. Is this bid supply only or supply and erect.

A1. The Department of Transportation intends to construct the four requested structures using their own manpower. However, this contract will be available to other State Agencies and political subdivisions that may not have the manpower to erect the structures. In that case, item 6 of Exhibit B- Price Schedule would offer an hourly labor rate.

Q2. For unit #4, this is an S model building 40x80-18. I think there's a typo for the arches it states 25 arches. That would make the building 50 feet long. Should it be 40 arches for 80 feet?

A2. The building dimensions listed are correct. The State is not concerned with the number of arches required to achieve the length of the structure. Bidders are encouraged to respond with the structure design, which includes the number of arches, which will be best suited to achieve the dimensions listed and compliant with the material specifications listed in Exhibit A- Description of Goods and Services.

Q3. Can we bid on 3 of the four buildings or does it have to be all four? Our 74 foot wide building does not meet the code requirements.

A3. You do not have to bid on all four buildings. In regard to the 74' wide building, the specification states "approved equals" will also be considered.
