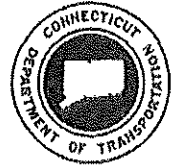

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) is seeking to engage Construction Contractors and Design Engineers to execute a Design-Build contract for the final design and construction of the subject Project.

This Project is located on I-691 in the City of Meriden and the Town of Southington, Project begins at log mile 1.32 (Route 5) and extends to log mile 4.84 (Route 322). It is anticipated that the scope of work under this Project will be as defined below. Aspects of the Project scope are subject to change prior to the issuance of the RFP.

Major project elements include, but not limited to the following:

- Pavement rehabilitation
- Roadway drainage and cross culvert investigation/repairs
- Minor bridgework
- Guiderail upgrades
- Highway design and construction
- Traffic engineering
- Illumination
- Contractor Quality Control
- Environmental permits



This solicitation is open to all Contractors prequalified in Work Classification Group No. 7 - Road Construction and Rehabilitation: Limited Access Highways/Freeways. Contractors that are not prequalified may apply for prequalification as outlined in the RFQ document attached. A Design Engineering firm is required to be part of the construction Contractor's team or the Construction Contractor must have qualified designers within its organization. Qualifications of the Design firm or designers within a Contractor's organization will be demonstrated through the information submitted in response to this solicitation.

Circumstances may require rescheduling or cancellation of projects, should such action be necessary the Department would be under no obligation to provide supplementary work for the teams selected for this project.
