INVITATION TO BID SOLICITATION # 2020-03

The City of West Haven (the City) is seeking bids from qualified contractors for the **Old Field Creek Hydraulic Dredging Project.** The project is located in West Haven at Old Field Creek between Beach Street and Blohm Street, and between Blohm Street and Marshall Street, and seeks to remove accumulated contaminated sediment, restore the ecological bed of Old Field Creek through hydraulic dredging, dewater the sediment over a historical unauthorized disposal area, and cap the dredged sediment. Work items include, but are not limited to: traffic control, pollution control, stream channel de-watering, clearing and grubbing, hydraulic dredging, seeding and mulching.

Work within Old Field Creek or which could affect water quality shall be completed between the dates of <u>May 16</u> and <u>September 30, 2020</u> and/or in accordance with the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection's Flood Management Certification permit.

Bids will be received by the City of West Haven at 355 Main Street, West Haven, CT 06516 until 11:00 AM, prevailing time, Friday, March 20, 2020, at which time they will be publicly opened and read. Bidders are responsible for the timely delivery of their Bid Proposal. Bid documents containing submittal requirements and forms will be available on Friday, February 21, 2020. A \$ 50.00 non-refundable check is due upon pickup.

It is the bidder's responsibility to ensure that any addenda issued during the bid period are obtained. Addenda, if any, will be issued only to those companies whose name and address are on record as having obtained Bidding and Contract Documents. A **Mandatory Site Showing** will be held on **Friday**, **February 28**, **2020 at 1:00 PM**. Minority and women's businesses are encouraged to apply.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project, and that the Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, creed, sex, color, national origin or sexual orientation. The Contractor will be required to pay wages to laborers and mechanics at least equal to the wage rates as determined by CT Department of Labor - Prevailing Wage Rate ID#: H26842, which rates can be viewed at the following website: https://www.ctdol.state.ct.us/wgwkstnd/prevailwage.htm and shall be made a part of the Contract. Federal Equal Opportunity and Labor Standards are applicable for all work performed under this Contract. Federal Wage Rates, appropriately determined under the Davis-Bacon Act, can be viewed at the following website: https://beta.sam.gov/.

A certified check or bank draft, payable to the order of the City of West Haven, negotiable United States Government Bonds (at par value), or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and an acceptable surety, in an amount equal to **at least five (5%) percent** of the Base Bid shall be submitted with each Bid.

The successful Bidder, to whom a Contract is awarded, will be required to execute a good and sufficient bond of

indemnity of a duly authorized surety company, equal to the full amount of the Contract, as security for the faithful performance on the part of the CONTRACTOR of all the covenants and agreements contained in said Contract and Specifications. Bid selection will be made to the lowest, qualified, responsible bidder. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities therein, and to select the Bid, the acceptance of which, in its judgment, will best assure the efficient performance of work. Bids may be held by the City for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of the opening of bids.
