All contractors must submit a sealed bid. It is the intention of the Town of Farmington to award the project to a single contractor under a single contract to the lowest responsible bidder. The Town of Farmington reserves the right to include or exclude any alternates in the calculation of the lowest bidder.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish and pay for 100% Performance and Payment Bond or Bonds, in the forms included in the Specifications.

Bidders, in addition to the qualifications listed in AIA document A305 and other qualifications identified in the project manual, must have successfully completed 3 projects for educational facilities, each with a construction cost of \$1 million dollars or more.

A satisfactory Bid Bond or Certified Check, in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the base bid, shall be submitted with each bid. The Bid Bond shall be made payable to The Town of FARMINGTON and shall be properly executed by the Bidder and acceptable sureties. All bonds must be from sureties listed on the most recent IRS Circular 570.

This project is state assisted and requires compliance with the Equal Employment Opportunity provisions of Executive Order 11246; Non Discrimination Provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; Prevailing Wage determinations as issued by the Connecticut Department of Labor; and other provisions outlined in the bid documents. The prevailing wage rates will be based on the bid value of each project. Prospective bidders, contractors and subcontractors whose bid exceeds five hundred thousand dollars, must be prequalified by the State of Connecticut Department of Administrative Services for the classification of work that they are bidding on.

This project is receiving State of Connecticut Construction Grant funding, which is estimated to be in excess of the minimum State threshold of \$50,000 requiring CHRO compliance. Contractors will need to comply with CT State Statues Chapter 814c, not limited to sections 46a-68b through k.

Bids, to receive consideration, must be in the hands of the authorized representative no later than the day and hour mentioned above. No bids shall be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the opening of bids, without the consent of the above Authority.
