The purpose of this addendum is to: **To answer the following questions, update proposal delivery instructions and provide a map of the parking infrastructure currently in place, with images by location.**

Q1: For infrastructure, we are wondering where the Multi Space Meters will be installed to see if there is existing concrete or if the City wants them installed on a dirt island where we would have to install a concrete pad?

A1: Please see attached for pictures of each location.

Q2: For the 8 spaces at 50 West Main Street, are those all next to each other?

A2: Please see attached pictures for the street parking locations. Please note that there is a group of spaces before the bump-out, and a group of spaces after the bump-out, including some handicap spaces.

- **Proposal Delivery** - Proposals may be dropped off prior to Thursday, April 23, 2020 either in person or by courier service. If respondents wish to drop off in person, you must do so by appointment per City Hall procedures. To make an appointment, please call (203) 630-4115 and a Purchasing Department Staff Member will meet you at the entrance to accept your bid and time/date stamp it. For those wishing to attend the bid opening and hand deliver your bid, Purchasing Department Staff will be outside the main entrance in the courtyard at City Hall to accept bids thirty minutes prior to the opening (10:30 AM).

At this time the City does not have the infrastructure to accept electronic proposals and therefore proposals will only be accepted as directed in the RFP documents.
