Proposer's Request:					
Our request for a window size of $24^{\prime\prime}$ x $36^{\prime\prime}$ in lieu of $24^{\prime\prime}$ x $30^{\prime\prime}$ was denied because GHTD "does not want to compromise the construction of the wall."					
Our Champion body structure was approved by GHTD as built and is structurally tested for our requested 24" x 36" window. The Body and Cage Structure meets or exceeds ALL Federal and State regulations. There is no compromising of the construction of the wall as it was engineered, built, tested, and approved for this window size.					
There is only one manufacturer that uses the requested 24" x 30" window size as standard. If that manufacturer changed the size of their windows, then only their wall construction would be compromised as it was not designed to accommodate a different sized window.					
Same rule applies to every manufacturer who requested a different sized window. We requested a different size because we did NOT want to compromise the construction of the wall and violate already approved safety standards. To deny this request renders this RFP Proprietary.
