I have a question on this RFP. The slides indicate that the contract tracers is healthcare assistance, vs CRC's who are non clinical. Can you please define the type of medical provider and responsibility that is needed of the contact tracers? LTMD has already been in contact with the state of CT, due to our interest to supply CT state healthcare facilities with physicians and mid level practitioners. If the need is for a MD, NP or PA medical provider, we are interest and able to provide this service, and will make a proposal/bid on the RFP. Can we propose just the medical practitioner and not the CRC? Can you please advise. Thank you!
