The Town of Beacon Falls, acting through its Finance Department, is seeking sealed bid proposals from qualified respondents for furnishing integrated municipal financial accounting software services located at the Beacon Falls Town Hall. Respondents must have demonstrated experience in providing such services and adhere to standards and requirements typical for such service. All submissions must be received in the Bonfire portal and labeled with RFQ/RFP/ITB number and title before the deadline: Thursday, August 6, 2020 at 4 p.m. An optional pre-bid teleconference will occur on Thursday, July 16, 2020 at 11 a.m. Zoom instructions will be posted separately beforehand. The full RFQ/RFP/ITB (including specifications) must be read in detail by all respondents prior to submission. All questions regarding the specifications may be directed, in writing only, within the Bonfire portal, by Thursday, July 23, 2020 at 4 p.m. Each respondent shall honor their proposal for (90) business days from the date of proposal opening, without modification.
