I. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The City of New Britain, on behalf of the School Building Committee, is seeking a qualified environmental engineering firm that can provide hazardous building materials consulting and underground storage compliance services, which will involve, inspection, preparing plans and specifications, and providing project oversight for the renovation of Chamberlain School as new, construct new additions and site improvements.

The site is the Chamberlain Elementary School located at 120 Newington Ave in New Britain, Connecticut.

The original school was constructed in 1951. Additions and renovations were completed in 1994. The project involves renovation and an addition resulting in an approximate 102,000 SF school building.

In June 2019, the City approved funding forty-nine million dollars (\$49 million) for this project. An ED049 application was file prior to June 30, 2019.

The newly renovated building shall include a new addition of approximately 16,580 square feet. Chamberlain School shall include:

- 24 General Classrooms
- Expand Administration Suite with additional office spaces
- Building Services Spaces New Mechanical Room, Janitor's Closet, Boys and Girls
- Lavatories, Storage
- Reconfigure Media Center
- Reconfigure cafeteria adding a STEAM Classroom

Site improvements will include:

- Improvements to bus drop-off/pick-up areas around the school to accommodate buses which will eliminate traffic jams around the school and improve student safety.
- Construction of new parking spaces including handicapped accessible spaces
- Site Work staff parking, bus pattern improvements
- Construction of new parent drop off areas

1. SELECTION OF SHORT-LISTED FIRMS

The School Building Committee shall review all Requests for Qualifications received and short list the most qualified firms. Selected firms shall then be notified in writing ASAP.

2. RECEIPT OF REQUESTS FOR QUALIFICATIONS

Pursuant to the "Invitation to Submit a Request for Qualifications", Requests for Qualifications documents for providing environmental engineering services will be received by Facilities Management as set forth therein. Qualification Statements received prior to the date set for receipt will be securely kept. Qualification Statements received by the time set for receipt will be opened and recorded.

II. SUBMISSION OF REQUESTS FOR QUALIFICATIONS

1. <u>COPIES REQUIRED</u>

The environmental engineer shall be required to submit four (4) original copies of their qualifications for these services to the Office of the Chief Facilities & Special Projects Officer by the time and date specified.

A fee proposal is not requested at this time.

2. REQUESTS FOR QUALIFICATIONS DOCUMENT

All interested firms are to submit a Statement of Qualifications to include the information listed below in the order presented with a Table of Contents to facilitate the RFQ review:

- A. Letter of Transmittal from each firm. The Letter of Transmittal shall indicate the firm's interest in the project, brief summary of their related experience, and any other information/experience that will assist the School Building Committee in making its selection.
- B. Basic Firm Information (may be simply listed), including:
 - a. Name of company
 - b. Date organized
 - c. Tax Identification number(s)
 - d. Legal form of ownership. If a corporation, where incorporated
 - e. Number of years engaged in services under present name
 - f. Identify and explain any work awarded to your company that your company has failed to complete
 - g. Identify and explain any instance in which your company has defaulted or has been accused of defaulting on a contract
 - h. Identify and explain any potential conflicts of interest
 - i. Identify the individuals who are authorized to bind the company in negotiations
 - j. Describe any previous and pending litigation or other factors that could affect your company's ability to perform this agreement
 - k. References

- A. Names of key personnel etc. with brief resumes of each describing background, experience and length of time with the organization.
- B. Number of staff in present firm including specific certification and/or licensure in disciplines for hazardous building materials and Licensed Environmental Professionals (LEP).
- C. Listing of names and address of all sub-consultants, sub-contractors and associates expected to be retained for this project including proposed laboratories for analysis.
- D. A representative listing of similar projects (Minimum of five) completed by the present firm in the last five years. Provide year of completion, description of project, owner's name, address and contact person.
- E. Consultants are requested to limit the information contained in their submission to only that information **as above requested and with a Table of Contents to facilitate review**. Submissions containing superfluous information will not be considered.
- F. Proof of Insurance.

III. METHOD OF SELECTION FOR CRITERIA FOR SHORT-LIST FINALISTS

The following factors will be considered by the School Building Committee in evaluating the Qualification Statements submitted for the award. The factors to be evaluated will not necessarily be evaluated in the order in which they are presented but will be appropriately weighted in descending order of importance:

- The technical competence of the firm;
- The firm's experience on similar renovate like new addition/underground storage tank projects;
- The firm's qualifications and experience of key personnel;
- Reputation of the firm based on references.

A. GENERAL

This RFQ is to cover the following services:

- Underground storage tank services including assessment, post removal soil/groundwater sampling, managing of soils and closure documentation to CTDEEP, local fire marshal and the CITY.
