Gentlemen:

At its Regular Monthly Meeting held on Tuesday, June 6, 2017, the Clinton Inland Wetlands Commission voted to approve the above-referenced application subject to the following conditions:

Special Condition:

1. Reference is made to the project drawings first dated May 25, 2017, with revisions through August 1, 2017. Authorized regulated activities shall be limited to that which is detailed within the referenced drawings and must be undertaken in conformance with the same.

General Conditions:

1. Not later than two weeks prior to the commencement of any work, permittee shall submit to the Clinton Inland Wetlands Commission the names and addresses of any contractor(s) employed to conduct such work and the expected date for commencement and completion of the work.
2. Permittee shall give a copy of the permit to the contractor(s) who will be carrying out the authorized activities.
3. Prior to conducting any of the authorized activities, erosion and sedimentation controls shall be installed per plan and/or the Wetlands Enforcement Officer and in accordance with the 2002 Ct. Guidelines for Soil Erosion and Sediment


- Control. Permittee shall maintain or modify, as needed, such controls to ensure optimal operating conditions until the authorized work has been completed.
4. Permittee shall not deviate from the referenced site plans and shall not make de minimus changes without the prior authorization of the Clinton Inland Wetlands Commission or the wetlands enforcement officer until the authorized work has been completed.
 5. On or before 90 days after completion of the authorized work, permittee shall submit "as-built" plans.

The wetland permit is enclosed.

The Legal Notice of Decision (copy enclosed) will appear in the Harbor News on Thursday, July 10, 2017, which will begin the 15-day appeal period during which any party aggrieved by this decision may file an appeal to Middlesex Superior Court, Middletown, Connecticut. The 15-day appeal period will end on Friday, August 25, 2017. Be advised that work begun prior to the end of the appeal period is undertaken at your own risk.
