All Invitations For Bids issued by the Department of Administrative Services, Procurement Services will bind Bidders to the terms and conditions listed below, unless specified otherwise in any individual Invitation For Bids.

Incorporated by reference into this contract are applicable provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes including but not limited to Sections 4a-50 through 4a-80 and applicable provisions of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies including but not limited to Sections 4a-52-1 through 4a-52-22.

The contractor agrees to comply with the statutes and regulations as they exist on the date of this contract and as they may be adopted or amended from time to time during the term of this contract and any amendments thereto.

Submission of Bids

- 1. Bids must be submitted on forms supplied by Procurement Services. Telephone or facsimile bids will not be accepted in response to an Invitation For Bids.
- 2. The time and date bids are to be opened is given in each bid issued. Bids received after the specified time and date of bid opening given in each bid proposal shall not be considered. Bid envelopes must clearly indicate the bid number as well as the date and time of the opening of the bid. The name and address of the Bidder should appear in the upper left hand corner of the envelope.
- 3. Incomplete bid forms may result in the rejection of the bid. Amendments to bids received by Procurement Services after the time specified for opening of bids, shall not be considered. An original and one copy of the proposal schedule shall be returned to Procurement Services. Bids shall be computer prepared, typewritten or handwritten in ink. Bids submitted in pencil shall be rejected. All bids shall be signed by a person duly authorized to sign bids on behalf of the bidder. Unsigned bids shall be rejected. Errors, alterations or corrections on both the original and copy of the proposal schedule to be returned must be initialed by the person signing the bid proposal or their authorized designee. In the event an authorized designee initials the correction, there must be written authorization from the person signing the bid proposal to the person initialing the erasure, alterations, or correction. Failure to do so shall result in rejection of bid for those items erased, altered or corrected and not initialed.

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Standard Bid and Contract Terms and Conditions

13. Samples are furnished free of charge. Bidder must indicate if their return is desired, provided they have not been made useless by test. Samples may be held for comparison with deliveries.

Award

- 14. Award will be based on quality of the articles or services to be supplied, their conformance with specifications, delivery terms, price, administrative costs, past performance, and financial responsibility.
- 15. Procurement Services may reject any bidder in default of any prior contract or guilty of misrepresentation or any bidder with a member of its firm in default or guilty of misrepresentation.
- 16. Procurement Services may correct inaccurate awards resulting from clerical or administrative errors.

Contract

- 17. The existence of the contract shall be determined in accordance with the requirements set forth above. However, the award of the contract is not an order to ship.
- 18. The Contractor shall not assign or otherwise dispose of their contract or their right, title or interest, or their power to execute such contract to any other person, firm or corporation without the prior written consent of Procurement Services.

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Tangible Personal Property

29. (a) For any contract for provision of tangible personal property to the state entered into on or after the effective date of this section, each department head, as defined in section 4-5 of the general statutes, shall enter into an agreement with the contractor pursuant to which such contractor shall agree, on its own behalf and on behalf of each affiliate, as defined in subsection (d) of this section, of such contractor, for the term of the state contract, to collect and remit to the state on behalf of its customers any use tax due to the state under the provisions of chapter 219 of the general statutes for items of tangible personal property sold by the contractor or by any of its affiliates in the same manner as if the contractor and its affiliates were engaged in the business of selling tangible personal property for use in this state and had sufficient nexus with this state to be required to collect use tax due to the state. (b) The following provisions shall apply to and be made part of any agreement entered into pursuant to subsection (a) of this section: (1) The contractor and its affiliates are not liable for use tax not paid to them by a customer; (2) A customer's payment of a use tax to the contractor or its affiliates relieves the customer of liability for the use tax; (3) The contractor and its affiliates shall remit all use taxes they collect from customers on or before the due date specified in the agreement, which may not be later than the last day of the month next succeeding the end of a calendar quarter or other tax collection period during which the tax was collected; and (4) Any contractor or affiliate who fails to remit use taxes collected on behalf of its customers by the due date specified in the agreement shall be subject to the interest and penalties provided for persons required to collect sales tax under chapter 219 of the general statutes. (c) Any agreement entered into under subsection (a) of this section may provide that the contractor and its affiliates shall collect the use tax only on items that are subject to the six per cent rate of tax. (d) For purposes of this section, "affiliate" means any person, as defined in section 12-1 of the general statutes, that controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with another person. A person controls another person if the person owns, directly or indirectly, more than ten per cent of the voting securities of the other person. For purposes of this subsection, "voting security" means a security that confers upon the holder the right to vote for the election of members of the board of directors or similar governing body of the business, or that is convertible into, or entitles the holder to receive, upon its exercise, a security that confers such a right to vote. "Voting security" includes a general partnership interest. (PA 03-01 Sec. 105)

Saving Clause

30. The Contractor shall not be liable for losses or delays in the fulfillment of the terms of the contract due to wars, acts of public enemies, strikes, fires, floods, acts of God or any other acts not within the control of or reasonably prevented by the Contractor. The Contractor will give written notice of the cause and probable duration of any such delay.

Advertising

31. Contractors may not reference sales to the State for advertising and promotional purposes without the prior approval of Procurement Services.

Rights

- 32. The State has sole and exclusive right and title to all printed material produced for the State and the contractor shall not copyright the printed matter produced under the contract.
- 33. The Contractor assigns to the State all rights title and interests in and to all causes of action it may have under Section 4 of the Clayton Act, 15 USC 15, or under Chapter 624 of the general statutes. This assignment occurs when the Contractor is awarded the contract.
- 33. Contractor agrees that it is in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations, including but not limited to Connecticut General Statutes Sections 4a-60 and 4a-60a. The Contractor also agrees that it will hold the State harmless and indemnify the State from any action which may arise out of any act by the contractor concerning lack of compliance with these laws and regulations.
- 34. Records, Files, and Information

Bidder agrees to make available and provide a right of access to PHI by the individual for whom the information was created and disclosed. Bidder agrees to make information available as required to provide an accounting of disclosures. Bidder agrees to make its internal practices, books, and records relating to the use or disclosure of PHI received from, or created or received by Bidder on behalf of the state agency/covered entity, available to the Secretary of Health and Human Services (HHS) for purposes of determining compliance with the HHS Privacy Regulations. At termination of this Contract, Bidder agrees to return or destroy all PHI received from, or created by the state agency/covered entity. If not feasible, extend the protections of this agreement to the PHI and limit further uses and disclosures. Bidder will have procedures in place for mitigating any harmful effects from the use or disclosure of PHI in a manner contrary to this Contract or the HHS Privacy Regulations. Tire and Tubes
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SCOPE:

The intent of this bid is to establish a contract to provide **Tires and Tubes and Related Services** for state-owned vehicles for All Other Using State Agencies (AUSA), and Political Subdivision of the State. This contract will cover the requirements for Regular Passenger Tires, Snow Tires, Police Pursuit Tires, Highway Truck and Bus Tires, Off Highway Tires, Industrial Tires, Farm Tires and Related Services.

MANDATORY EXTENSION OF CONTRACT:

Bidders are required to offer this contract (including pricing, terms and conditions) to All Using State Agencies, Political Sub-Divisions of the State, including but not limited to towns, municipalities, public school systems and certain not-for-profit organizations. When a Political Sub-Division and/or Not-for-Profit Organization utilizes this contract all references to the "State" are hereby replaced with the name of the using Political Sub-Division or Organization.

CONTRACT PERIOD:

The State intends that this contract shall be in effect from Date of Award through **August 31, 2008**. The State reserves the right to extend this contract for a period of up to the full original contract term or parts thereof.

SPECIAL REOUIREMENTS:

For services, contractors and/or its subcontractors MUST be licensed by the Connecticut Department of Motor Vehicle (DMV). Awarded contractor(s) must maintain and be current for the life of the Contract all licensing and registration requirements per DMV rules and regulations. Awarded contractor(s) must adhere to and comply with all applicable federal, state, and town laws, rules, and regulations in regard to the operation of their business, operation of motor vehicles and employment of personnel.

Tires offered must adhere to and comply with all applicable federal and state laws, rules, and regulations. The letters "DOT" on the tires certify compliance with all applicable safety standards established by the U.S. Department of Transportation. Tire Disposal: Scrap tires are defined "special waste" [RCSA Section 22a-209-1] as opposed to municipal solid waste because they require special handling. Connecticut no longer permits the landfilling of scrap tires, either whole or in pieces. Most scrap tires in Connecticut are burned to create energy at the tire-to-energy facility in Sterling. Also there are volume reduction facilities that process tires. If you store more than 10 cubic yards of scrap tires (approximately 100 passenger car tires), you are required to obtain a solid waste permit. [RCSA Section 22a-208a] For more information, visit CT-DEP's website www.dep.state.ct.us/wst/recycle/tires.htm or call the CT-DEP's Recycling Program at (860) 424-3022.

Bidders must include (on a separate page) a detailed description of methods used for compliance to all DEP and Environmental laws, rules, and regulations and any copies of applicable permits issued by DEP.

Bidders shall include the following additional documentation with bid:

Tire and Tubes

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All vehicles, tools, necessary equipment, safety devices, and skilled personnel to perform all services under the terms of this contract shall be the sole responsibility of the awarded contractor(s). Awarded contractor(s) will be responsible for executing good engineering and safety practices in all related services performed for this contract. Contractor(s) shall employ only such workers as are skilled/licensed in the tasks to which they are assigned. The State reserves the right to require the Contractor to reassign any employee it deems incompetent, careless, insubordinate, or otherwise objectionable to work under this contract.

The tires and tubes shall show no evidence of poor workmanship. All tire plies including cap or breaker shall be smoothly and evenly laid and shall be free of buckles, wavy cords, air pockets, or other imperfections. Awarded contractor(s) is responsible for the reimbursement of vehicle damages due to improper handling, poor workmanship, and storage.

Bidders who are certified by DAS as a Small/Minority Business (SBE/MBE) are required to provide a copy of the company's current certification certificate.

BID PRICES:

All bids shall include transportation and delivery charges fully prepaid by the contractor F.O.B. destination within the State of Connecticut. An hourly rate is requested for labor required to make the necessary repairs. *Only original Equipment Type Tires (Or Higher Quality) shall be considered for the contract award.* Note: Tire fees are no longer applicable.

WARRANTY:

Each bidder shall clearly state the type of warranty they will offer.

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE:

The successful bidder(s) shall, when requested, promptly furnish at no cost to the State qualified technical personnel at the job site to assist in solving any tire service problem resulting from use of contractor's product on state vehicles.

ENVIRONMENTALLY PREFERABLE BID SUBMITTAL ENCOURAGED:

The State is dedicated to waste reduction and the practice of using and promoting the use of recycled and environmentally preferable products and services. To promote these values, all Bidders are encouraged to submit bids following these guidelines:

- All copies should be printed double sided except the Proposal Schedule.

- Bids should be submitted in a format that allows for the easy removal of recyclable materials.

In addition to the use of recycled content paper, Bidders are encouraged to use other products that contain recycled content in their bids.

BID OPENING:

Bidders are encouraged to attend the public bid opening of this bid, on the date and time specified in the bid documents. Due to the numerous bids issued, contract specialists are unable to read bid results over the telephone. Once the contract is awarded, a copy of the contract award can be viewed on the DAS/Procurement website – www.das.state.ct.us/busopp.asp. If the contract does not show up, it probably means that the contract has either not been awarded or hasn't yet been posted to the website. No additional information will be given, while bids are under evaluation.

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BUSINESS OPERATIONAL CHANGES:

In the event that the awarded contractor moves, updates telephone numbers or changes their name, it is the responsibility of the contractor to advise the State of such changes in writing. The State will not be held responsible if payments or purchase orders are delayed due to additional routing caused by lack of notification on the contractor's part. BASIS OF AWARD:

The State reserves the right to award by item, groups of items, total bid or to make a multiple award. The State further reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive technicalities and to make awards in a manner deemed in the best interest of the State.

- Overall completeness and quality of line offered and size of stock maintained in warehouse.
- Ability to comply with the required E-Commerce requirement.
- Adequacy of bidder's network of dealers located throughout the State of Connecticut, and who will supply emergency pick-up at the quoted prices, and who regularly carry suitable quantities of the type and sizes of tires and tubes bid on, and have facilities for providing mounting and balancing services;
- Ability of the bidder to render satisfactory service, including; A representative to call upon and consult with various State agencies regarding their requirements; Location of warehouse.

NOTE: FAILURE TO INCLUDE A COPY OF YOUR CONNECTICUT REPAIRER/DEALER LICENSE SHALL BE BASIS FOR AUTOMATIC REJECTION OF YOUR BID.

INSURANCE:

Contractor shall not commence SERVICE under this contract until he has obtained all insurance required under this Section, nor shall the Contractor allow any subcontractor to commence SERVICE on his subcontract until all similar insurance required of the subcontractor has been obtained.

- A) <u>Commercial General Liability</u>: \$1,000,000 Combined Single Limit per occurrence for bodily injury, personal injury and property damage. Coverage shall include Premises and Operations, Independent Contractors, Products and Completed Operations, Contractual Liability and Board Form Property Damage coverage. If a general aggregate is used, the general aggregate limit shall apply either separately to the project or the general aggregate limit shall be twice the occurrence amount.
- B) <u>Automobile Liability</u>: \$1,000,000 Combined Single Limit Automobile Liability insurance shall be maintained against claims for damages resulting from bodily injury, including wrongful death, and property damage which may arise from the operations of any owned, hired or non-owned automobiles used by or for the Contractor in any capacity in connection with carrying out this contract.
- C) <u>Workers Compensation and Employers' Liability</u>: Statutory coverage in compliance with the Compensation laws of the State of Connecticut. Coverage shall include Employers' Liability with minimum limits of \$100,000 each accident, \$100,000 disease-each employee, and \$500,000 disease-policy limit.
- D) Minimum Scope of Insurance: All Liability insurance policies shall be written on an "occurrence" basis only. All insurance coverage is to be placed with insurers authorized to do business in the State of Connecticut and must be placed with an insurer that has an A.M. Best's Rating of no less than A-, VII. All certificates of insurance shall be filed with the Department of Administrative Services on the standard Acord Certificate of Insurance form showing the specified insurance and limits. The State of Connecticut shall be named as an Additional Insured. The contractor's insurer shall have no right of recovery of subrogation against the State and the contractor's insurance shall be primary coverage.

The certificate of insurance shall contain a party for notice clause, and please have your agent list the contract award number on the certificate.

INVOICING:

Successful contractor(s) will render Invoices upon completion of order. Please follow invoicing instructions contained in the boiler-plate of the purchase order. The State's payment terms are **Net 45**. Deviation from Net 45 is not acceptable, however, cash discounts for prompt payments may be offered (e.g. 2% 10 days). Invoicing must be in accordance with state policy and include:

- 1. Vendor T.I.N. or Social Security Number
- 2. Complete contractor name and billing address
- 3. Invoice Number and date
- 4. Purchase order number
- 5. Itemized Commodities and/or Services

Invoices received without reference to a valid State purchase order number will result in delay of payment.

P-Card (Purchasing Credit Card):

The State of Connecticut uses a MasterCard purchasing card for order placement and payment in many instances. Suppliers who accept credit cards should anticipate that some or all orders issued as a result of this bid may be paid by using the purchasing card. The Supplier shall be aware that he/she is responsible for the credit card user handling fee associated with credit card purchases. Suppliers should only charge to the State's MasterCard when the goods are delivered (physical receipt of goods, at store), or are shipped. NON-PERFORMANCE CLAUSE/COMPLAINT REPORTS:

Should it be found that the quality of services being performed is not satisfactory, and that the requirements of the specifications are not being met, the contractor shall be informed, by the using agency, of said deficiency and shall be given an opportunity to correct the offending condition. The time allowed to correct the condition shall be specified and will be reasonable depending on the nature of the non-performance. *In the event that the contract award has been terminated, the awarded contractor will complete all work currently underway, and the agency will make payments for all services received and completed.*

If the complaint was resolved by the agency, the agency should fill out a Vendor Performance Report "for information only" purposes and forward to DAS/Procurement Services. The vendor performance report will be filed at DAS/Procurement Services and may be used in the future when evaluating the contractor's past performance with the State.

If the complaint cannot be resolved between the using agency and the contractor, the using agency will fill out a Vendor Performance Report and forward to DAS/Procurement Services. A copy of the Vendor Performance Report shall be forwarded to the contractor and the contractor shall respond back to DAS/Procurement Services by a designated date on how they will correct the problem. The contractor will be afforded ten (10) business days from the date of receipt of a negative report to correct the problem. DAS/Procurement Services may terminate services where the contractor performance remains unsatisfactory after receiving two (2) negative written reports and if need be, employ another Contractor to fulfill the requirements of the contract. Also, at any time, the State may decide to meet with the Contractor to try and come to an agreement with or without terminating the contract. Depending on the nature and severity of the complaint, the contractor may be terminated after the first vendor performance report. The Contractor being terminated may be liable to the State

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of Connecticut for all costs incurred as a result of the termination, including additional costs to employ a new contractor for the length of the contract.

SUBLETTING/ASSIGNING OF CONTRACT:

The Contract or any portion thereof, or the work provided for therein, or the right, title, or interest of the Contractor therein or thereto may not be sublet, sold, transferred, assigned or otherwise disposed of to any person, firm, or corporation, or other entity without the prior written consent of the State. No person, firm or corporation, or other entity, other than the Contractor to whom the project was awarded is permitted to commence work on the project unless such consent has been granted.

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS / AUDIT:

The awarded contractors are required to furnish the Department of Administrative Services with a summary of the total purchases made under this contract on a **quarterly basis**.

At the option of the State and at its own expense, periodic audits may, at reasonable times, be made of the Contractor's books and records insofar as they pertain to the Contract. Such audits will be conducted by the State or a representative appointed by the State. Said books and records shall be made available to the Auditors of Public Accounts of the State of Connecticut.

E-COMMERCE (**Electronic Commerce**): The State utilizes an internet-based E-Procurement ordering system (PeopleSoft), known as Core-CT. Companies receiving awards from this bid may receive purchase orders from the State of Connecticut through this system.

Companies may be required to provide the State of Connecticut with functional data files including detailed product and pricing information. These files will then be loaded into a catalog on this system for ordering purposes. Companies that do not and/or cannot comply with these requirements, when required, and/or fail to provide functional data files within a reasonable amount of time (as specified by the State) may be terminated from a contract award.

GIFT AFFIDAVITS:

The award contractor will be required to annually submit an updated Gift/Campaign Contribution Affidavit.

PRICE ADJUSTMENTS:

Prices shall remain firm for the first year of the contract with the exception of price decreases. **Price decreases** will become effective immediately. The Contractor shall bill the State at the reduced price on all deliveries made on or after the date of the price reduction. The Contractor shall promptly provide DAS/Procurement Services with a letter of notice concerning the decrease in pricing.

After the first year of the contract period, the awarded contractor(s) may file for a price adjustment consistent with and relative to price changes originating with the manufacturer and/or the market trends on an annual basis.

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The new pricing medium must be sent with the request for adjustment Requests for such an adjustment must be fully and properly documented and, if approved, shall be firm for until the next annual anniversary date of the contract. The State reserves the rights to reject any requested price adjustments if the best interests of the State will be served.

To request a price adjustment, the contractor(s) must submit a formal request to the Contract Specialist at the Department of Administrative Services/Procurement Services, Box 150414, Hartford, CT 06115-0414, within thirty (30) days of the annual anniversary date of the contract. If approved, price adjustments shall become effective ten (10) days after the approval. Retroactive adjustments shall not be allowed. Any purchase orders issued by any State agency prior to the effective date will be honored by the Contractor at the price in effect at the time off the issuance of the purchase order.

OUESTIONS:

If a bidder has any questions about this bid or finds any discrepancies or contradictions in the specifications or doubt as to the meaning of any provision, the bidder must notify Procurement Services in writing at least ten (10) days prior to the bid opening date. OPEN ENROLLMENT:

This bid is intended to accommodate agency requirements for towing services. If all geographic regions in the State of Connecticut are not sufficiently covered by the contractors listed on the contract award, contractors may be added to the contract, if deemed to be in the best interest of the State. This is an open enrollment contract. After the initial deadline date of this Bid, additional bidders may submit a response to the Bid proposal only as requested by DAS/Procurement Services. However, all bidders are encouraged to meet the deadline, since vendors will NOT be permitted to submit random proposals at their own discretion. DAS/Procurement Services will only add qualified contractors, after a thorough proposal review, to cover any justified unmet needs, if deemed in the best interest of the State.

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Making a Pit Stop

There are over 5,200 vehicle service facilities in Connecticut (auto-body and repair shops, gas stations, fleets, vocational-technical schools, junkyards). DEP's <u>Pit Stops</u> program is designed to provide outreach to these facilities so they are aware of environmental requirements and P2 opportunities. Pit Stops fact sheets cover topics such as antifreeze,

vehicle painting, and shop wastewater, and are scheduled for an update next year to reflect regulation changes and new topics like mercury switch removal. Presentations based on Pit Stops topics are held for organizations representing the automotive services industry including the Connecticut Auto Recyclers Association, Connecticut Automotive Trades Association, American Public Works Association, and CT Towing and Recovery Professionals of Connecticut. DEP is developing an environmental compliance checklist and training that will be used during DMV inspections. DEP will track checklist information in a database, and compliance assistance will be provided. An accompanying brochure on Best Management Practices (BMPs) and P2 tips is also being developed for facility managers.
